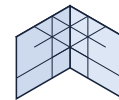
Company	2021	2022	2023
A	420	480	540
B	360 ♦	405	450
C	540	486	624
D	288	336	384
E	460	500	575

RULE — RATIO OF TWO CELLS

Write the two values, then divide both by their HCF.

- 1 Company D in 2023 = **384**; Company B in 2021 = **360**.
- 2 Ratio = **384 : 360** ; and HCF(384, 360) = 24.
- 3 Divide both by 24 = **384/24 : 360/24 = 16 : 15**

✓ **Answer: 16 : 15** — a real question & solution from our bank.

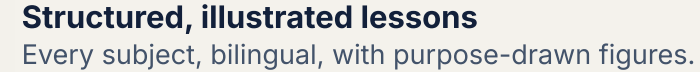

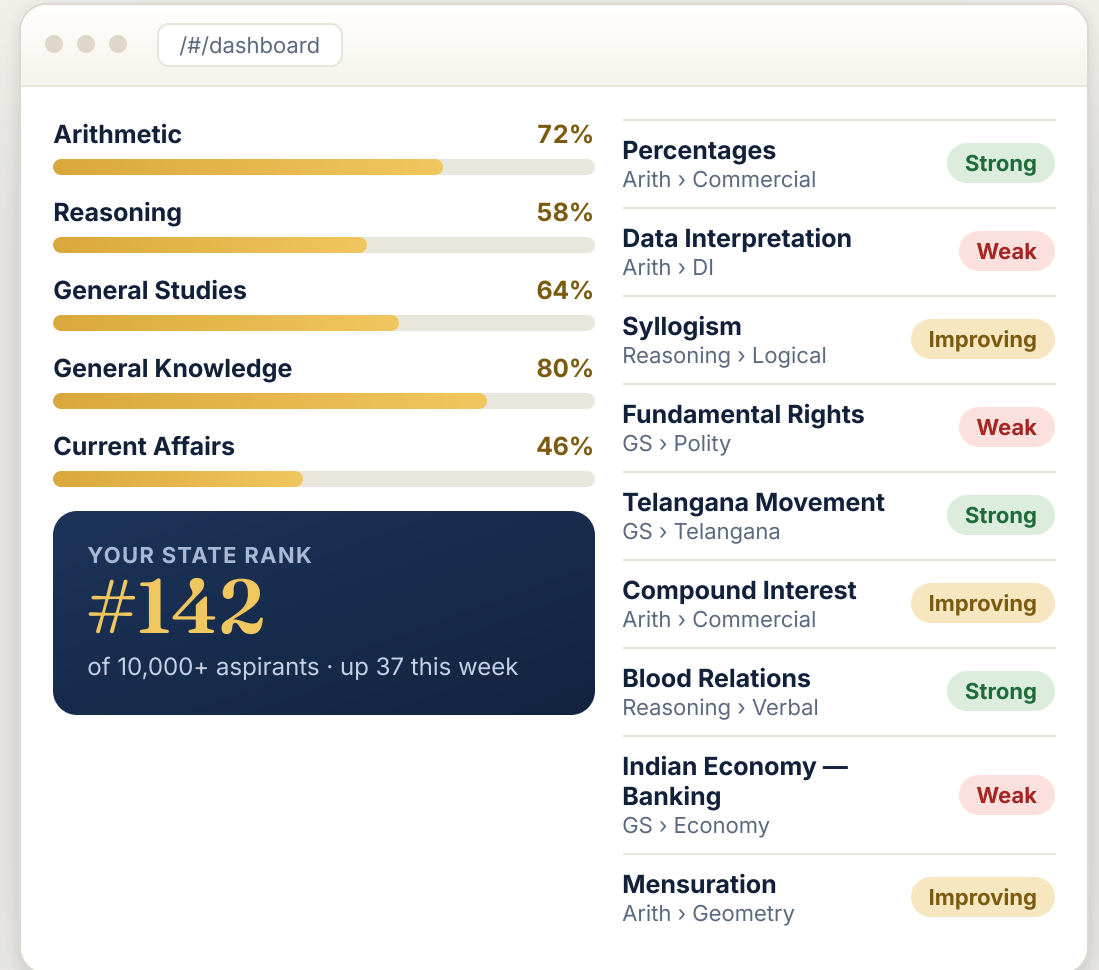
